- 1. Cementum, s.r.o., with its registered office at Slunečná 1279/27, 664 91 Ivančice, ID 09916920 registered at the Regional Court in Brno, Section C, Insert 121620 (hereinafter referred to as the "Seller" or "Controller") processes within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation"), the following personal data:
 - name, surname
 - e-mail address
 - telephone number
 - address/registered office
- 2. The above personal data must be processed for the handling of orders and further performance of the contract if a purchase contract is concluded between you and the seller. Such processing of personal data is permitted by Article 6(1)(b) Regulation processing is necessary for the performance of a contract.

The Seller also processes these data for the purpose of recording the contract and possible future application and defense of the rights and obligations of the parties. The storage and processing of personal data is for the above purpose for a period of 10 years from the implementation of the last part of the performance under the contract, unless another legal regulation requires the preservation of contractual documentation for a longer period. If you object, we will no longer send you the questionnaire.
